If you have a veterinarian not in our Silver Paws program, we may not be able to provide assistance. Our coordinator will contact them about the program to determine if they are willing to participate.

You must contact the Silver Paws Coordinator at **217-5468** **before** making your appointment. She will contact the vet's office to let them know you will be calling for an appointment. Any appointments already completed cannot be covered if not previously authorized.

Silver Paws does not support on-going treatments or medications for chronic care such as diabetes, hypo/hyperthyroidism, or cancer. The program is not set up for emergency treatments or procedures. If you are unable to pay for euthanasia for an ill pet and the pet has been seen by a veterinarian who determines it is terminal, Silver Paws will pay for euthanasia. The program will not pay for private cremations or mementoes.

Silver Paws is dedicated to keeping pets healthy by helping their senior companions. We have limited funds and strive to help as many pets as possible.
